

My current appointments include Executive General Manager and Director with Infront Security Services Group, Director on the RSL Queensland Board (RSL QLD), membership on the RSL QLD Nomination and Remuneration Committee, and a student at Australian Defence College.

Across my career, I have developed deep understanding and capability in legal, risk, and compliance oversight, ensuring organisations meet statutory obligations, uphold best-practice governance standards, and operate with integrity. I bring extensive experience in government relations and policy, representing organisational interests, strengthening stakeholder relationships, and contributing to policy settings that impact the veteran, community, and broader security sectors. Since 2018, I have served in the Army Reserves, fulfilling appointments as 2IC of B Company 9 RQR, Aide-de-Camp to the Governor of Queensland, Officer Commanding B Squadron 12/16 Hunter River Lancers, and currently posted as a student at the Australian Defence College completing Command and Staff College (Part-Time). I aspire to be a future Commanding Officer within the Reserves. My operational experience includes warlike service in Iraq, domestic support during Operation COVID-19 Assist, and multiple international exchanges, including Exercise Longlook, Rifle Company Butterworth, and as a student with the United States Marine Corps completing the Amphibious Warfare Officers Course.
