NOTE 1 - A person who willfully makes a false statement in a statutory declaration under the *Statutory Declarations Act* 1959 is guilty of an offence against that Act, the punishment for which is a fine not exceeding \$200 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or both if the offence is prosecuted summarily, or imprisonment for a team not exceeding four years if the offence is prosecuted upon indictment.

<u>NOTE 2</u> - A statutory declaration under the *Statutory Declarations Act* 1959 may be made only before a Magistrate, a Justice of the Peace, a Commissioner for Affidavits, a Commissioner for Declarations, a Notary Public, a person before Whom a statutory declaration may be made under the law of the State in which the declaration is made, or an Australian Consular Officer or an Australian Diplomatic Officer.
